## Danish trade with Kosovo

#### **Export**

- Goods exports to Kosovo rose by 41,8 % in 2022 in relation to 2021. (FOS)
- The top export in 2022 was medicinal and pharmaceutical products (DKK 24,0 million). (FOS)
- In 2023, Danish exports of goods to Kosovo were worth DKK 95,4 million; a fall of 10,4% relative to 2022 (DKK 106,4 million). (FOS)

- Imports of goods from Kosovo totalled DKK 6 million in 2022; a fall of 23,7% relative to 2021.(FOS)
- The top import good in 2022 was road vehicles (including air-cushion vehicles) (DKK 2,9 million). (FOS)
- In 2023, imports of goods from Kosovo were worth DKK 12,5 million; a rise of 124,3% in relation to 2022 (DKK 5,6 million). (FOS)

# **Economic key figures for Kosovo**

- Kosovo was the world's 158th largest economy in 2022 with a GDP of 9.410 million USD.
- In 2022 the country had a population of 1,8 million.
- According to the World Bank's 2022 classification, Kosovo belongs to the group of Upper middle income countries. The GDP per capita of the country was 5.341 USD in 2022.
- In 2023 the real growth rate in GDP is expected to be 3,4 pct., and over the following two years real GDP is expected to grow at a rate of 3,9 pct. p.a.
- In 2022 the current account had a deficit of 10,3 pct. of GDP. Towards 2025, the current account is expected to strongly improve, but remains negative.
- In 2022 the government budget balance had a deficit of 0,7 pct. Towards 2025, the budget balance is expected to somewhat worsen and the deficit increases further.
- Total government debt is expected to increase to 21,9 pct. of GDP in 2025.
